





Environmental NGO views on the draft final Market Assessment of Directional Mains-Voltage Lamps (Stage 3 requirements of Commission Regulation (EU) No 1194/2012)

Environmental NGOs welcome the draft final market assessment of directional mains-voltage lamps, in relation to the application of Stage 3 requirements detailed in Commission Regulation (EU) No 1194/2012.

On the basis of the aforementioned assessment, the Commission has outlined in a note put forward to the Consultation Forum, that lamps available on the market fulfill all the necessary conditions laid out in Regulation 1194/2012 for Stage 3 to apply to mains-voltage filament lamps. We fully agree with this conclusion, which is further reinforced by the supplemental market research and the related, in depth analysis undertaken by CLASP¹. Consequently, we call for Stage 3 to take effect as foreseen in Regulation 1194/2012 - on the 1st September 2016, so that the expected savings potential² (25 TWh annually by 2020) can be fully reaped.

In addition, and concerning future ecodesign requirements, we recommend against the use of conditional language, to ensure legal certainty already from the entry into force of future regulations.
